



Finding Shades and Highlights

The TCS On-Line Network offers more than 18,000 suggested shades and highlights. Anytime you see a TCS number on your screen it is nearly always “blue with an underline”. This indicates it is a link to more information. Clicking on this link allows a “Drill Down*” function where you can find suggested shades and highlights.

1. From any list of TCS Identifier links, click on one, and a new window will appear. Note at the top of this new window a command line with these links:
 - 1) Previous TCS # | Next TCS # | Help | Print | Close Window
2. Choose any brand color name or mix that you would like to see the Shade and Highlight and click on its **S/H** button (right side of the screen) and another Pop-Up window will appear.
3. A Pop-Up window will appear that shows:
 - 1) The color name or mix you selected
 - 2) A suggested Shade for this color with TCS ID.
 - 3) A suggested Highlight for this color with TCS ID. The S & H color names will always be in the same brand as the original target color.
 - 4) Click the TCS Number if you want to learn ALL colors in all the brands (and your inventory) of this single TCS ID.

* **Drill Down** means you can click on these sequenced underlined TCS ID's to see more and more information. However, you can go too far from the original target color and then the data is no longer relevant.

Tip: If this window is NOT full screen, you can click the Restore button to expand it to full screen size. (Restore is on the Title bar, upper right corner of screen, square box next to the red X close button.).
